INSPECTION REPORT

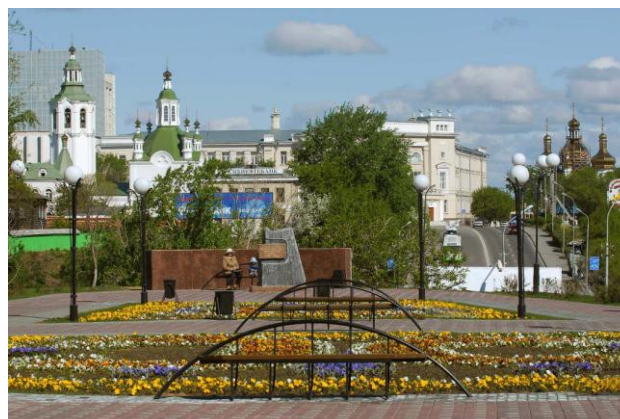
ATTRACTIONS:

The city of Tyumen is an administrative centre of Tyumen Region (one of the largest regions of Russia), the FIRST Russian city in Siberia, the so called "The Gate of Siberia".

It was founded in 1586 by the detachment of Russian Cossacks sent by Tsar Ivan the Terrible to follow in the tracks of the expedition of Ermak.

Being suitably located at a crossing of important water and land trade ways the city became one of the strongholds of the Russian power behind the Urals. In 1885 Tyumen was intersected by Trans-Siberian Railway, the longest in the world, and that finally consolidated the position of the city as economic centre of Western Siberia.

Nowadays, Tyumen is beautiful modern city, a large industrial, business, scientific and Cultural centre of Western Siberia, the capital of oil and gas territory with the population of more than 600 thousands people. There are more than 100 large enterprises, 20 educational institutions (universities, academies and institutes), theatres, concert halls and circus of European level.



THE ORGANIZER:

The Governor of Tyumen Region Mr. Vladimir V. Yakushev, the Government of Tyumen Region, world famous bodybuilding club "Antey" and Russian Bodybuilding and Fitness Federation are very pleased to invite all European National Federations, EBFF members to Tyumen on European Women's Bodybuilding, Fitness, Bodyfitness, Bikini and Men's Fitness Championships.

You can be sure that we have done everything we could to assure you to feel good and welcomed in Western Siberia, Russia.

Through the Russian Federation of Bodybuilding & Fitness under the leadership of its President Mr. Vladimir Dubinin and, particularly through the life dedication work of General Secretary of FBFR and the President of Tyumen City club "Antey" Mr. Eugene Koltun Tyumen is very meaningful appreciated city for EBFF.

"Antey" Club will celebrate its 44th Anniversary on February 20th, 2011. It is a training place of many world-known female competitors, such as Elena Davidova -1996 European Bodybuilding Champion, Zhanna Babanina - 1998 European Fitness Runner-up, Natalia Proskuryakova - 2-times World Bodybuilding Champion (2000, 2002), Natalia Gurievskikh - 2004 World Fitness Overall Winner, Anna Sorokina - 2005 European Bodyfitness Runner-up, Elina Gook - World Women's Bodyfitness Vice-Champion (2009) and 3-times World Bodyfitness Junior Champion (2004, 2005, 2009), Yulia Ushakova - Women's Bodyfitness Champion of Russia-2010, Overall winner of the World Junior's Bodyfitness-2010. All of them worked out under the guidance of Eugene Koltun.

"Antey" Club has got a great experience, organizing top-level International "Tyumen Grand Prix" Contests (1989, 1990, 1992, 1993, and 2002).

The "1993 Tyumen Grand Prix" was a great success (22 countries participated) and enjoyed recognition of Mr. Ben Weider and Mr. Rafael Santonja.

1994 European Men's and Women's Championships were also organized in Tyumen in June. 32 European countries took part in this event which was the grandiose success also. On June 16-17, 2007 in Tyumen was organized the European Junior's and Master's Bodybuilding, Fitness and Bodyfitness Championships. The best competitors from 20 countries participated in this great event, which had a very high organizing level.

OFFICIAL HOTEL:

The official Hotel of the Championships is the "VOS TOK " Hotel.



Hotel's services: Business centre including PC, Wi-Fi, photocopying, international telephone, faxing, etc.

VENUE SITE:

The Prejudging and Finals will take place in the multi-purpose sport facility “Tsentralny”, which seats 1000-1200 spectators. The 2007 European Junior’s and Master’s Championships had the same venue.



ACCOMMODATIONS:

1. The organizer will cover 3 night's accommodations and 3 meals per day, starting with lunch on Friday, May 27, 2011 **FOR A-TEAM**, according to the following IFBB rules:
3 or more athletes: 2 delegates allowed.
less than 3 athletes: 1 delegate allowed.

The members of B-Team must pay for the Official Package.

Delegates with no athletes may attend but at his or her own expense.

2. The Official Arrival Date is Friday, May 27, 2011.
The Official Departure Date is Monday, May 30, 2011.
3. EFBB Executive Council Members will arrived on May 26, 2011 and will be accommodated in single rooms having broad bed (for 2 persons in case they would prefer to be accompanied by one person who will live in the same room).
4. Delegates and competitors will be accommodated in double rooms (two persons per room).

SPECIAL PACKAGE:

A Special Package Price has been established for B-Team competitors, Extra-Delegates and Supporters arranged by the organizer which includes:

Official Package:

1. 3 nights hotel accommodation (from May 27 till May 30, 2011)
2. three meals per day (from lunch on May 27 to breakfast on May 30, 2011)
3. tickets to the prejudging and finals
4. ticket to farewell banquet
5. transportation

One person per room – € 450

Two people per room – € 400 (per person).

EARLY ARRIVALS/LATE DEPARTURES:

Any National Federation arriving before the official arrival date of Friday May 27, 2011 and staying on after the official departure date of Monday May 30, 2011 will be responsible for all of their own expenses including arranging their own transportation between the airport and the hotel. Hotel rate for extra days: one night for one person in single-room - EUR 60, one night for one person in double-room - EUR 40 (breakfast is included).

HOTEL DEPOSIT:

An initial deposit of €100 per person is required upon check-in for incidental and personal expenses which may arise (telephone, laundry, room service, mini-bar, etc). The unused portion of this deposit will be returned at check-out time. In order to facilitate matters, the chief delegate or team leader will be asked to provide a credit card or cash to cover the deposit for the entire team. This individual will be fully responsible for all expenses incurred by any members of the team. **PLEASE INFORM THE MEMBERS OF YOUR TEAM BEFORE DEPARTURE NOT TO CREATE ADDITIONAL EXPENSES.**

THE A-TEAM

1. Each National Federation may enter an A-team. The maximum allowable number of competitors in the A-Team shall be equal to the total number of categories open for competition at the Championships; in this case, 11 competitors: 2 in Women's Bodybuilding, 2 in Women's Fitness, 4 in Women's Bodyfitness, 1 in Men's Fitness and 2 in Women's Bikini.
2. The maximum allowable number of A-team competitors per National Federation in any one category shall not exceed two (2).
3. Pursuant to applicable IFBB rules, the Organizer shall provide free-of-charge accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Prejudging, Finals and Farewell Banquet to all A-team competitors.
4. Each National Federation shall pay a Registration Fee of EURO 150 for each A-team competitor and delegate.
5. The A-team competitors shall compete for placings and awards, including the Best National Team award.
6. A National Federation must fully declare its A-team competitors on the Final Entry Form and must register the A-team competitors upon check-in at the official hotel, failing which any undeclared competitor shall be responsible for all of his or her expenses.

THE B-TEAM

1. Each National Federation may enter a B-team according to the rules specified below. Unless otherwise noted, the maximum allowable number of competitors in the B-team shall not exceed those in the A-team; in this case, 11 competitors: 2 in Women's Bodybuilding, 2 in Women's Fitness, 4 in Women's Bodyfitness, 1 in Men's Fitness and 2 in Women's Bikini.
2. Unless otherwise noted, the maximum allowable number of B-team competitors per National Federation in any one category shall not exceed two (2).
3. The National Federation shall be obliged to pay the Full Special Package Rate of EURO 450 (in single room) or EUR 400 (in double room) for each B-team competitor. This package shall comprise the competitor accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Prejudging, Finals and Farewell Banquet (included participation/registration fee of EURO 150).
4. The B-team competitors shall compete for placings and awards, but will not be included in the Team's Classification.
5. A National Federation must fully declare its B-team competitors on the Final Entry Form and must register the B-team competitors upon check-in at the official hotel, failing which any undeclared competitor shall be disqualified.

According to Article 9.4, point 20 of the IFBB Rules, the host National Federation may enter B-Team as well as C-Team, the same like A-Team, with up to a maximum of 2 C-Team competitors in any one category. C-Team competitors may compete for placing and awards, but will not be included in the Team's Classification. All C-Team competitors must be declared before the start of the Official Athlete Registration.

Important: any judges, coaches, or trainers and supporters who are not official A-team delegates will be responsible for all their own expenses.

BACKSTAGE/DRESSING ROOM ACCESS:

Access to the backstage area and dressing room area shall be strictly limited to essential personnel **ONLY**. Coaches and trainers who assist athletes in the dressing room **MUST BE OF THE SAME SEX AS THE ATHLETE THEY ARE ASSISTING**.

CAMERAS/VIDEOTAPES:

Cameras and videotapes shall be strictly prohibited in the backstage area and dressing room area except when used by duly recognized press personnel and, in any event, these devices shall be **STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE DRESSING ROOM AREA**.

DRESS CODE. PARADE OF NATIONS:

The dress code for all delegates or officials for the Parade of Nations is as follows:

1. For men: black dress shoes, dark socks, grey dress pants, white shirt, IFBB tie, and blue blazer with IFBB crest.
2. For women: black shoes, grey dress pants or grey dress skirt, white shirt or white blouse; blue blazer with IFBB crest (if a white shirt is worn, the IFBB tie must also be worn).

EBFF REGISTRATION FEE

Official **A-Team** Athlete and Delegate must pay EUR 150 (Registration fee). This fee is payable upon arrival at the Official Hotel in Tyumen. The EBFF Registration Fee is completely separate from the hotel security deposit.

NOTE: If the National Team consists of three (3) or more athletes - two (2) official delegates are permitted at the expense of the Organizing Committee, should the National

Team consist of one (1) or two (2) athletes – only one (1) official delegate is permitted.
Any additional delegate, has to pay the special package detailed in page 4.

WEIGH-IN:

The weight-in and registration will take place in Hotel “VOSTOK” on Friday, May 27, 2011 at 19:00. It is the responsibility of the head of delegation to make sure that the athletes are on time. Any athletes who are late will not be accepted to participate.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE:

Official language is Russian. In hotels, bars and restaurants you will always find English speaking staff.

CURRENCY:

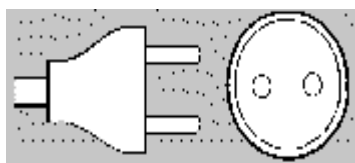
The official currency is Russian Ruble. One Euro is approximately 40-41 Rubles. One US dollar is approximately 30-31 Rubles.

Changing money legally is no longer the logistical problem or the blatant rip-off it used to be. Exchange offices abound, particularly in the center and around touristy areas. For people who just don't want to wait in line, or for those who get their thrills by risking getting ripped-off, a hard currency black market still exists and is ever willing to serve.

CLIMATE:

During the end of the month of May the average temperature is around +10-15 degrees C.

NATIONAL ANTHEM:

All participating National Federations must bring the music of their national anthem (shortened version).

POSING MUSIC:

All posing music can be provided on DVD or CD with the correct side indicated. The music must be at the beginning of CD. Each competitor must affix their name upon their DVD or CD for easy identification.

NOMINATION FOR INTERNATIONAL JUDGES:

All National Federation are reminded that their nominations of judges to the Championships must be also included in the Final Entry Form, according to the Amendments to the Rules: *that a National Federation must provide on the Final Entry Form the names of all judges (including test judges) nominated to officiate at the competition, failing which the individual will not be allowed to judge. All IFBB/EBFF International Amateur Judges must be in possession of a valid Judges card.*

All judges nominated by National Federations will have to pass the test of basic judging knowledge to be included in the official judging panels. This test will be run by the EBFF Judges Committee during the Technical Meeting.

Judges payment for 2011 is EUR 50.

VISAS:

Important notice from Russian Federation, please read it carefully

Due to the Russian Law, the procedure to get Russian visa has become a bit more difficult. In order to get the official invitation for obtaining Russian visa for taking part in the European Women's Bodybuilding, Fitness and Bodyfitness & Men's Fitness Championships in Tyumen - May 27 -30, 2011 you should prepare the following information:

- The list with data of **each member** of your delegation.
- This information should contain: **first name, last name, date of birth, passport number with date of issue and date of expiry.**
- The passport should be valid for a minimum of six months after visa expiration date.
- The planned dates of entry and leaving of Russia.
- According to the Russian consulate regulation you are supposed to present THE ORIGINAL of your official invitation. The Official Invitations for **each member** of the national delegation will be sent to the official address of your national federation (to the name of its President) because of it we need the exact mail address and contact phone.
- **THE OFFICIAL INVITATIONS – IS NOT THE ENTRY DOCUMENT IN RUSSIA! ONLY THE VALID RUSSIAN VISA IN YOUR PASSPORT WILL GIVE YOU THE RIGHT TO DO SO!**
- **NB! – Please, be sure that you have insurance for all the term of your being in Russia.**
 - Take to consideration that getting Russian visa at the Embassy will take you about 10 (ten) days.

All the above information should be included in ONE LIST, signed by the President/Gen. Secretary and must be sent **to the e-mail addresses of the Head Quarter of Russian Bodybuilding and Fitness Federation for Mr. Vladimir Dubinin: dubinin@fbfr.ru , NOT LATER than May 01, 2011.**

AIRPORT:

The official airport of arrival is "ROSHINO" Airport of Tyumen City.

It is very easy to reach Tyumen by airplane through Moscow or Saint-Petersburg. The flight time from Moscow to Tyumen is 2.5 hours and from Saint-Petersburg - 3 hours.

BUS SERVICE:

A bus service will be organized to take the athletes and delegates from and to the airport "ROSHINO" (20 min by bus).

TIME:

GMT + 5 hours.

DRUG TESTING:

Doping control will be conducted by the IFBB Medical Commission pursuant to the IFBB Anti-Doping Rules, using the WADA accredited laboratory.

In order to compete in the Championships, all competitors at the Weigh-in and Registration will be required to sign a *Doping Control Consent & Waiver of Liability Form*. The IFBB is a Signatory to the WADA Code. Participating National Federations have a duty and an obligation to ensure that their National Team athletes are competing drug-free at IFBB international competitions.

National Federations with no athletes may send one (1) official delegate; however, this delegate will be responsible for all of his or her expenses. Any judges, coaches, or trainers who are not official delegates will be responsible for all of their expenses.
